Keller Public Library Board Minutes

The board of Keller Public Library met January 29, 2026, at 5:15 p.m. in the genealogy room. Those in attendance were Kurt Lovelady, Nicole Guethle, Katie Mayberry, Donna Becker, Whitney Wilson, Adam Clark, Randy Russell, and Jordan Myers.

President Kurt Lovelady called the meeting to order. Adam made the motion to approve the minutes of the December meeting. The second was made by Nicole. The motion carried.

Treasury Report:

Jordan reviewed the treasury report for October and November 2025. Total receipts for October \$5,780.21 and total disbursements for October \$29,022.15. Total receipts for November \$6,824.88 and total disbursements for November \$14,142.87. Whitney made a motion to approve the treasury report for October and November 2025. The second was made by Nicole. The motion carried.

Library Report:

There were two story hour dates in November and three story hour dates in December. All dates had good attendance. Statistics were still good for visitors and check outs.

Old Business:

We received quotes for the expansion of the community room. Rick Shipman Construction submitted a bid of \$99,997. Hook's Construction Co. submitted a bid of \$106,363. J.R. Kennedy Construction submitted a bid for \$107,250. Adam moved that we accept the bid from Rick Shipman Construction, and Nicole made the second for the bid. The motion carried. The city council will vote on the expansion of the community room this upcoming Monday night.

The leak in the roof has been fixed, and the sheet rock damage will be fixed this summer.

New Business:

Local author, Nathan Justice, called Jordan about doing a book signing at the library. He has written a young adult novel. Jordan said he will have the book signing in the foyer sometime during the fall 2026, after the completion of the community room expansion. Jordan will check with Friends of the Library for sponsoring him.

Friends of the Library:

The Spring Dinner is scheduled for Sunday, March 29th. Tickets are currently being sold, \$15/ticket.

Discussion:

One of the mini-splits is down in the community room. Jordan said it is still under warranty and will check into getting it fixed.
